A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE PLANNING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION	1.	The	legislature	finds	that	the	Hawall	State	

- 2 Planning Act was enacted in 1978 to improve the planning process
- 3 and guide future development of the State. The Hawaii State
- 4 Planning Act sets forth the Hawaii state plan, which articulates
- 5 goals and policies to guide the development of the State and
- 6 establishes an integrated planning and implementation system
- 7 regarding those goals and policies. The last review of the
- 8 Hawaii State Planning Act was initiated in 1983 and completed in
- 9 1985 and resulted in several amendments to the Hawaii State
- 10 Planning Act. Since then, there have been significant changes
- 11 in Hawaii's economic, physical, and social conditions;
- 12 technology; and the global marketplace. The State also faces
- 13 new constraints and opportunities as it plans for the future.
- 14 Thus, the legislature finds that a comprehensive review of the
- 15 Hawaii State Planning Act, chapter 226, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 16 is now warranted.

5	(5)	Identify and analyze significant issues, emerging
6		issues, problems, and opportunities confronting the
7		State as they relate to the Hawaii State Planning Act;
8	(6)	Solicit, review, and analyze proposals for amendments
9		to the Hawaii State Planning Act from the general
10		<pre>public;</pre>
11	(7)	As appropriate, provide reports, recommendations,
12		strategies, and alternative courses of action to the
13		governor regarding the Hawaii State Planning Act; and
14	(8)	Review and analyze the county planning process and the
15		impact it has on county permitting and the number and
16		type of projects breaking ground in the State.
17	Not	later than thirty days prior to the convening of the
18	regular s	ession of 2018, the office of planning shall submit a
19	written r	eport to the legislature of its findings,
20	recommend	ations, and proposed legislation, regarding its review
21	and propo	sed updates to the Hawaii State Planning Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for
- 4 reviewing, analyzing, reporting, and proposing updates to the
- 5 Hawaii State Planning Act.
- 6 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of
- 7 planning for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
