# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JOINT FORMULARY ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the joint formulary 2 advisory committee established by the department of commerce and 3 consumer affairs should be repealed because it is obsolete and 4 unnecessary in recommending the applicable formulary for advanced practice registered nurses with prescriptive authority. 5 6 The board of nursing is the authority that determines the 7 qualifications and scope of practice of advanced practice 8 registered nurses with prescriptive authority, and the board is already the authority that determines the applicable formulary or exclusionary formulary for licensees under its authority. If 10 11 necessary, the board of nursing may consult with other boards, 12 such as the board of pharmacy or Hawaii medical board, on 13 questions pertaining to prescription drugs. Other resources,

12	considered qualified if they have met the requirements of
13	section 457-8.5(a), and have met the advanced pharmacology
14	requirements for initial prescriptive authority pursuant to

16	registered nurse authorized to diagnose, prescribe, and
17	institute therapy or referrals of patients to health care
18	agencies, health care providers, and community resources and,
19	only as appropriate to the practice specialty in which the
20	advanced practice [+]registered[+] nurse is qualified, may:

Repeal; Joint Formulary Advisory Committee; Board of Nursing

### Description:

Repeals the Joint Formulary Advisory Committee established by the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs. Allows the Board of Nursing to be the sole authority that determines the exclusionary formulary for qualified advanced practice registered nurses with prescriptive authority. (SD1)

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
