A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2
- 3 "(a) The University of Hawaii shall be headed by an
- 4 executive board to be known as the board of regents.
- 5 The board shall consist of fifteen voting members [-] and
- one ex officio nonvoting member who shall be a current tenured 6
- 7 faculty member of the University of Hawaii who does not
- 8 currently hold and has never held a University of Hawaii
- 9 administrative position. At least one voting member shall be a
- University of Hawaii student at the time of the initial 10
- appointment. [This] The ex officio nonvoting tenured faculty 11
- 12 member and the student member may be reappointed for one
- additional term. The student member [may be reappointed for one 13
- additional term even though the member may no longer] need not 14
- be a student at the time of reappointment. The governor shall 15
- 16 reduce the terms of those initially appointed to each seat on
- the board of regents to provide, as far as practicable, for the 17

- 1 expiration of three terms each year; provided that the term of
- 2 the student member shall not be reduced.
- 3 At least twelve voting members, except for the student
- 4 member, shall represent and reside in the specified geographic
- 5 areas as follows:
- 6 (1) Two members from the county of Hawaii;
- 7 (2) Two members from the county of Maui;
- 8 (3) One member from the county of Kauai; and
- 9 (4) Seven members from the city and county of Honolulu.
- 10 The board shall have the power, in accordance with the
- 11 Hawaii [constitution] State Constitution and with law, to
- 12 formulate policy and to exercise control over the university
- 13 through its executive officer, the president of the university.
- 14 The board shall have exclusive jurisdiction over the internal
- organization and management of the university."
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 304A-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 18 "(a) The affairs of the university shall be under the
- 19 general management and control of the board of regents. The
- 20 board shall consist of fifteen voting members [who] and one ex
- 21 officio nonvoting member who shall be a current tenured faculty

- 1 member of the University of Hawaii who does not currently hold
- 2 and has never held a University of Hawaii administrative
- 3 position. All members shall be appointed by the governor from
- 4 lists of qualified candidates presented to the governor by the
- 5 candidate advisory council, pursuant to section 304A-104.6, and
- 6 shall be confirmed by the senate; provided that if the list of
- 7 qualified candidates includes fewer than three candidates at any
- 8 time during the nomination and confirmation process, the
- 9 governor may request that the candidate advisory council reopen
- 10 recruitment for qualified candidates. Members may be removed by
- 11 the governor. Except as otherwise provided by law, state
- 12 officers shall be eligible for appointment and membership.
- 13 The term of each member shall be five years, except as
- 14 provided for the initial appointment in section 26-11; provided
- 15 that the term of the ex officio nonvoting tenured faculty member
- 16 and student member shall be two years. Every member may serve
- 17 beyond the expiration date of the member's term of appointment
- 18 until the member's successor has been appointed by the governor
- 19 and confirmed by the senate in accordance with article X,
- 20 section 6 of the Hawaii State Constitution. Members shall serve
- 21 no more than two consecutive five-year terms; provided that the

- members who are initially appointed to terms of two years or 1
- less pursuant to section 26-11(a) may be reappointed to two 2
- 3 ensuing five-year terms. If a member is to be appointed to a
- second term of five years, the senate shall consider the 4
- question of whether to reconfirm the member at least one hundred 5
- twenty days prior to the conclusion of a member's first five-6
- 7 year term; provided that if the senate is not in session within
- 8 one hundred twenty days prior to the conclusion of the member's
- first five-year term, the member shall continue to serve until 9
- 10 the senate convenes for the next regular session or the next
- special session for which the senate is authorized to consider 11
- the question of reconfirmation." 12
- SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 13
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 15

University of Hawaii; Board of Regents; Ex Officio Nonvoting Faculty Member; Term

Description:

Amends the composition of the University of Hawaii's board of regents by adding a current University of Hawaii tenured faculty member who does not currently hold and has never held an administrative position as an ex officio nonvoting member to serve a two year term and authorizes the governor to reappoint the member for one additional term.
