BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the annual Merrie
- 2 Monarch Festival continues to inspire the perpetuation of
- 3 Hawaiian traditions through a week-long festival that features
- 4 an invitational Hawaiian arts fair, a grand parade, and an
- 5 internationally acclaimed hula competition.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 7 the perpetuation of the annual Merrie Monarch Festival.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 as a
- 11 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to The
- 12 Merrie Monarch Festival for the perpetuation of the annual
- 13 Merrie Monarch Festival.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the state
- 15 foundation on culture and the arts for the purposes of this Act.
