A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that accurate firearm 2 registration records and the sharing of firearm registration 3 records between the counties are critical to ensure the safety 4 of the community. Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to 5 allow the Hawaii criminal justice data center to view firearm registration data as part of a firearm registration information 6 7 sharing initiative between the county police departments. SECTION 2. Section 134-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 8 9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 10 Every person who acquires a firearm pursuant to "(b) section 134-2 shall register the firearm in the manner 11 prescribed by this section within five days of acquisition. 12 The registration shall be on forms prescribed by the attorney 13 14 general, which shall be uniform throughout the State, and shall include the following information: name of the manufacturer and 15 16 importer; model; type of action; caliber or gauge; serial 17 number; and source from which receipt was obtained, including the name and address of the prior registrant.
