A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 and to read as follows: 3 "§321- License, relicense, certification, and 4 5 recertification fees. (a) The department shall charge and collect fees for the licensure, relicensure, certification, and 6 recertification of the following facilities: 7 (1) Not more than \$ per year for adult residential 8 9 care homes; (2) Not more than \$ per year for expanded adult 10 residential care homes; 11 (3) Not more than \$ per year for developmental 12 disabilities domiciliary homes; 13 (4) Not more than \$ per year for community care 14 15 foster family homes; (5) Not more than \$ per year for adult day care 16 **17** centers;

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1	<u>(6)</u>	Not more than \$ per year for adult foster
2		homes for developmentally disabled individuals; and
3	(7)	Not more than \$ per year for case managers
4		having purview of facilities specified in paragraphs
5		(1) to (6).
6	(b)	The fees shall be deposited into the general fund to
7	support t	he licensing, relicensing, certification, and
8	recertifi	cation of facilities specified in this section.
9	<u>(c)</u>	The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
10	91 as nec	essary to carry out the purposes of this section."

12	to the le	gislature no later than twenty days prior to the
