### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue

5	unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.
6	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the capital
7	improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act shall be
8	expended by the following expending agencies for the purposes of
9	this Act:
10	(1) For item 1, the department of land and natural
11	resources;
12	(2) For item 2, the department of education;
13	(3) For item 3, the department of health; and
14	(4) For items 4 to 6, the department of transportation.
