A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that residents of the
- 2 island of Hawaii would greatly benefit from the addition of an
- 3 advanced life support ambulance to augment the Hawaii county
- 4 emergency medical services system for residents of the Makalei
- 5 area. The population of this area has significantly increased
- 6 over the years, which has corresponded with a steady increase in
- 7 calls for emergency medical services.
- 8 The legislature further finds that access to primary health
- 9 care in Makalei is challenging for the community. For many
- 10 residents, primary care services are as many as thirty miles
- 11 away. Coupled with economic and transportation challenges,
- 12 emergency medical services have become the access point for
- 13 health care to many residents.
- 14 Due to the lack of resources, it has become common for
- 15 medics to have up to ten transports in a twenty-four hour shift.
- 16 The potential for fatigue resulting in errors in judgment,
- 17 driving, and overall safety are of great concern for personnel
- 18 and residents.



1 The legislature further finds that a new advanced life 2 support ambulance will help reduce death and disability among 3 residents and visitors on the island of Hawaii. A timely 4 response to a 911 call is critical to increase the likelihood of 5 successful outcomes for injured or sick individuals. Given the 6 island's significant growth and aging population, an advanced 7 life support ambulance is needed and will be cost-effective. 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for an 9 advanced life support ambulance to be based in the Makalei area 10 on the island of Hawaii and to be used during daily peak hours 11 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., including the acquisition of a **12** vehicle and equipment, and funding personnel costs for state-13 certified emergency medical service personnel. 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 16 thereof as may be necessary for the fiscal year 2015-2016 and **17** the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for the 18 fiscal year 2016-2017 for one advanced life support ambulance to 19 be:

(1) Based in Makalei on the island of Hawaii; and

- 1 (2) Used during daily peak hours from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 2 p.m.;
- 3 and to include the acquisition of a vehicle and equipment, and
- 4 funding personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical
- 5 service personnel.
- 6 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 7 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
