A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that consumer protection
- 2 is extremely important to the State and that the roles of
- 3 adjusters and public adjusters under the insurance code need to
- 4 be amended to protect the interests of the people of Hawaii.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to make amendments to the
- 6 definitions of "adjuster" and "public adjuster" and to add
- 7 definitions for "insurance appraiser" and "insurance umpire" in
- 8 the insurance code to protect the interests of the people of
- 9 Hawaii.
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 431:9-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 1. By adding two new definitions to be appropriately
- 13 inserted and to read:
- 14 ""Insurance appraiser" means a person that is appointed by
- 15 either the insured or the insurer as may be further defined in
- 16 the policy's appraisal clause and who shall be competent and
- 17 well-versed in chapter 431.
