- 12 prohibition; permit renewal. (a) Beginning July 1, 2016, no
- 13 new underground storage tank shall be permitted within one
- 14 hundred yards of the shoreline.
- 15 (b) Beginning January 1, 2045, no person shall operate an
- 16 underground storage tank within one hundred yards of the
- 17 shoreline, and no permit for an underground storage tank within
- one hundred yards of the shoreline shall be renewed."

SECTION 3. Section 342L-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 2 and to read as follows: 3 ""Shoreline" means the upper reaches of the wash of the 4 waves, other than storm and seismic waves, at high tide during 5 6 the season of the year in which the highest wash of the waves 7 occurs, as evidenced by the edge of vegetation growth or the upper limit of debris left by the wash of the waves." 8 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 9 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050. 11

Description:

Bans new underground storage tanks within one hundred yards of the shoreline, as of 7/1/2016. Prohibits operation of and renewal of a permit for an underground storage tank within one hundred yards of the shoreline, as of 1/1/2045. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (SD1)
