A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOANALUA GARDENS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Moanalua Gardens is 2 a popular twenty-three acre community park and tourist 3 attraction. Over the years, many local residents and tourists 4 have visited Moanalua Gardens and enjoyed the park's natural 5 beauties including but not limited to wildlife, plants, and 6 cultural artifacts. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate 7 funds for the State to acquire Moanalua Gardens in order to 8 permanently protect and preserve one of the State's most 9 treasured cultural and historical areas. 10 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue 11 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$7,000,000 or so much 12 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017 14 for the purpose of capital improvement projects, as follows: 15 Purchase of Moanalua Gardens 16 Land acquisition \$7,000,000
