BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 249-31.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	A disabled veteran who:
4	(1)	Is a resident of Hawaii;
5	(2)	Has been other than dishonorably discharged from the
6		United States uniformed armed forces; and
7	(3)	Is determined by the United States Department of
8		Veterans Affairs or its predecessor to have a service-
9		connected one hundred per cent disability rating for
10		compensation or a service-connected disability rating
11		of one hundred per cent[; and
12	(4)	Is in receipt of disability retirement pay from any
13		branch-of the uniformed armed forces],
14	shall be	exempt from [payment of all annual vehicle registration
15	fees as r e	equired by section 249-31.] the tax imposed under this
16	chapter.	This exemption shall not extend to vehicles used for

- 1 commercial purposes, nor to more than one vehicle owned by the
- 2 disabled veteran."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to motor vehicle
- 4 registrations issued or renewed after January 1, 2017.
- 5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
