A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§291-51.6 Issuance of temporary removable windshield
- 4 placards[-]; photograph; barcode. (a) The issuing agency shall
- 5 issue one temporary removable windshield placard to each
- 6 applicant who requests and presents a certificate of disability
- 7 that verifies the duration of the applicant's disability in
- 8 monthly increments, which shall not exceed six months, and upon
- 9 payment of a fee to the issuing agency. Upon request of an
- 10 applicant who was previously issued one temporary removable
- 11 windshield placard, a second temporary removable windshield
- 12 placard shall be issued to that applicant upon verification of
- 13 the applicant's disability.
- 14 (b) A temporary removable windshield placard shall bear:
- 15 (1) A photograph of the person to whom the placard is
- issued; and
- 17 (2) A barcode for electronic identification purposes."

1	SECTION 2. Section 291-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§291-52 Issuance of removable windshield placard[+];
4	<pre>photograph; barcode. (a) The issuing agency shall issue one</pre>
5	removable windshield placard to each applicant who presents a
6	certificate of disability that verifies that the applicant's
7	disability is expected to last for at least six years. The
8	removable windshield placard shall expire six years after the
9	date of its issuance.
10	(b) A removable windshield placard shall bear:
11	(1) A photograph of the person to whom the placard is
12	issued; and
13	(2) A barcode for electronic identification purposes."
14	SECTION 3. Section 291-52.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	"§291-52.5 Issuance of identification card[-]; photograph.
17	The issuing agency shall issue one identification card at the
18	same time it issues a removable windshield placard, temporary
19	removable windshield placard, or special license plates to a
20	person with a disability. The identification card shall bear a

1	photograph of the person to whom the card is issued and a
2	barcode for electronic identification purposes."
3	SECTION 4. Section 291-52.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:
5	"§291-52.6 Replacement of a removable windshield placard
6	or identification card[-]; photograph; barcode. (a) A
7	removable windshield placard, temporary removable windshield
8	placard, or identification card shall be replaced upon:
9	(1) Submittal to the issuing agency of a completed
10	application for a removable windshield placard,
11	temporary removable windshield placard, or
12	identification card to the issuing agency; and
13	(2) Payment of a fee.
14	(b) A replacement removable windshield placard shall bear
15	(1) A photograph of the person to whom the placard is
16	issued; and
17	(2) A barcode for electronic identification purposes."
18	SECTION 5. Section 291-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	"§291-57 Parking spaces reserved for persons with
21	disabilities; misuse of identification card or placard; false



1	statement	s; penalties. (a) Any person who uses a parking space
2	reserved	for persons with disabilities who:
3	(1)	Fails to properly display a removable windshield
4		placard, a temporary removable windshield placard, or
5		special license plates;
6	(2)	Displays an invalid removable windshield placard, an
7		invalid temporary removable windshield placard, or
8		invalid special license plates;
9	(3)	Uses a removable windshield placard, a temporary
10		removable windshield placard, or special license plate
11		that was not issued to that person or to any
12		passengers occupying the vehicle in the parking space;
13		or
14	(4)	With or without a removable windshield placard, a
15		temporary removable windshield placard, or special
16		license plates:
17		(A) Parks in an access aisle; or
18		(B) Obstructs the ingress or egress to a parking
19		space reserved for a person with a disability;
20	shall be	guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and
21	shall be	fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$500 and pay any

1	costs inc	urred by the court related to assessing the fine;
2	provided	that a person with a disability who has been issued a
3	valid pla	card or special license plate that is currently in
4	effect, a	nd who has failed to display the placard or license
5	plate whi	le parking in a space reserved for persons with
6	disabilit	ies, shall pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more
7	than \$100	and any costs incurred by the court related to
8	assessing	the fine.
9	(b)	Any person who:
10	(1)	Uses an identification card, temporary removable
11		windshield placard, removable windshield placard, or
12		replacement removable windshield placard, that was
13		previously issued to a person who is now deceased,
14		shall be fined \$1,000; and
15	(2)	Makes a false statement or provides misinformation for
16		the purpose of obtaining an identification card,
17		temporary removable windshield placard, removable
18		windshield placard, or replacement removable
19		windshield placard shall be subject to a fine of not
20		more than \$10,000, and imprisonment of not more than
21		eighteen months.

$[\frac{b}{b}]$ (c) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for
persons with disabilities and refuses or fails to present an
identification card issued under this chapter or the rules
adopted thereunder to an enforcement officer upon request shall
be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and shall
be fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$500.
$[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ Any citation issued under this chapter may be
mailed to the violator pursuant to section 291C-165(b)."
SECTION 6. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Parking for Disabled Persons; Placards; Identification Cards; Penalties

Description:

Requires an identification card, temporary removable windshield placard, removable windshield placard, and replacement removable windshield placard to bear a photograph of the person to whom the placard or identification card is issued, and a barcode for electronic identification purposes. Establishes penalties for using an identification card, temporary removable windshield placard, removable windshield placard, and replacement removable windshield placard previously issued to a person who is now deceased, and for making a false statement or providing misinformation for the purpose of obtaining a placard or identification card.
