BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 414-44, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+] \$414-44[+] Ultra vires. (a) Except as provided in 4 subsection (b), the validity of corporate action may not be 5 challenged on the ground that the corporation lacks or lacked 6 power to act. 7 (b) A corporation's power to act may be challenged: 8 (1)In a proceeding by a shareholder against the 9 corporation to enjoin the act; 10 (2) In a proceeding by the corporation, directly, 11 derivatively, or through a receiver, trustee, or other legal representative, against an incumbent or former 12 13 director, officer, employee, or agent of the 14 corporation; or 15 (3) In a proceeding by the attorney general under section 16 414-411.

1	(c) In a shareholder's proceeding under subsection (b)(1)
2	to enjoin an unauthorized corporate act, the court may enjoin or
3	set aside the act, if equitable and if all affected persons are
4	parties to the proceeding, and may award damages for loss (other
5	than anticipated profits) suffered by the corporation or another
6	party because of enjoining the unauthorized act.
7	(d) A corporation's political activities in any form shall
8	be deemed to constitute an ultra vires act for purposes of this
9	section if the corporation:
10	(1) Does not describe in writing to shareholders,
11	including in any proxy, consent, or authorization, the
12	specific nature and total amount of anticipated
13	expenditures for political activities for the
14	forthcoming fiscal year; and
15	(2) Does not provide for prior approval by a majority vote
16	in a separate vote of shareholders of outstanding
17	shares for any expenditure under paragraph (1)."
18	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
