#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATEWIDE TRAFFIC CODE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 291C-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+] \$291C-41[+] Drive on right side of roadway; 4 exceptions. (a) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a 5 vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows: 7 (1)When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction under the rules governing such 8 9 movement; 10 (2) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to 11 drive to the left of the center of the highway; 12 provided that any person so doing shall yield the 13 right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in the proper 14 direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway 15 within such distance as to constitute an immediate 16 hazard;

### S.B. NO. 346

#### Report Title:

Traffic Safety; Trucks; Speed Limit

#### Description:

Prohibits certain large vehicles of more than 10,000 pounds from being driven on the far left lane of any roadway having three or more lanes, with certain exceptions. Establishes a fifty-five mile per hour speed limit for trucks having a gross vehicle weight rating in excess of 10,000 pounds.
