A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii livestock 2 industries consistently identify the cost of import feed as the
- 3 most expensive input for their operations. Hawaii's need to
- 4 subsidize import feed due to the lack of a local feed mill begs
- 5 the question of whether Hawaii can sustain the livestock
- 6 industry at such a scale. Even after years of local workshops
- 7 and research, the local feed situation has not improved. The
- $oldsymbol{8}$ department of agriculture has identified potential feed
- 9 ingredients that exist in Hawaii and has initiated a feed
- 10 development process to identify, assess, and validate available
- 11 local feed ingredients.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 155D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 14 and to read as follows:
- "§155D- Grants; qualified feed developer. (a)
- 16 Applications for grants submitted by qualified feed developers
- 17 shall be submitted on a form furnished by the department and



1	shall be	filed with accompanying documentation of feed
2	developme	nt costs; provided that:
3	(1)	The applicant shall comply with applicable federal and
4		state laws prohibiting discrimination against any
5		person on the basis of race, color, national origin,
6		religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or
7		disability;
8	(2)	The applicant shall have applied for or received any
9		applicable licenses or permits;
10	(3)	The applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the
11		State and its officers, agents, and employees from all
12		claims arising out of or resulting from the feed sold;
13		and
14	(4)	The grant shall not exceed a total of \$200,000 per
15		qualified feed developer per year.
16	(b)	The department shall:
17	(1)	Define "feed development costs" for the purposes of
18		this section; and
19	(2)	Determine whether the definition of "feed development
20		costs" shall include the cost of transporting feed
21		equipment to the State.

1	(c) Documentation of animal feed development costs, as
2	requested by the department, shall be filed for feed developed
3	within the immediately preceding fiscal quarter of filing and
4	shall be effective for feed development costs incurred after
5	June 30, 2015.
6	(d) The applicant shall submit a quarterly financial
7	statement of farm revenues and expenses along with other
8	supporting documents as deemed necessary by the department and
9	filed with the documentation of the feed development costs. An
10	annual financial statement shall be filed with the department
11	within ninety days following the close of the business' fiscal
12	year after June 28, 2015, for final reconciliation of any
13	reimbursement paid during the previous three quarters within the
14	fiscal year. The financial statements shall be certified as
15	accurate by the applicant and the preparer of the financial
16	statement on forms prepared by the department.
17	(e) Funds shall be disbursed upon approval by the
18	department to the qualified feed developer for up to fifty per
19	cent of the feed development costs incurred.
20	(f) In no case shall costs be reimbursed to a qualified

feed developer when, after evaluation and verification by the

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- 1 department, the department determines that the amount of
- 2 reimbursement will result in an annual profit of more than ten
- 3 per cent.
- 4 (g) The department shall quarterly aggregate the total
- 5 grant claims pursuant to this section and divide and disburse
- 6 the available grant funds on a pro rata basis."
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 155D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 9 and to read as follows:
- 10 ""Qualified feed developer" means any person that, at the
- 11 time of application for and disbursement of funds under this
- 12 chapter, is in the business of cultivating feed crops."
- 13 SECTION 4. Section 155D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Applications for grants by qualified producers shall
- 16 be submitted on a form furnished by the department and shall be
- 17 filed with accompanying documentation of animal feed costs;
- 18 provided that:
- 19 (1) The applicant shall comply with applicable federal and
- 20 state laws prohibiting discrimination against any
- 21 person on the basis of race, color, national origin,

1		religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or
2		disability;
3	(2)	The applicant shall have applied for or received all
4		applicable licenses or permits;
5	(3)	The applicant shall indemnify and hold harmless the
6		State and its officers, agents, and employees from all
7		claims arising out of or resulting from the feed
8		purchased;
9	(4)	The subsidy shall not be allowed within a fiscal
10		quarter if the flock or herd size or, in the case of
11		fish or crustaceans, sale weight, falls five per cent
12		or more below the required minimum of:
13		(A) Thirty birds;
14		(B) Ten cows;
15		(C) Ten sows in any two months of the applicable
16		fiscal quarter;
17		(D) Twenty finished beef cattle annually;
18		(E) Twenty-five lactating milking goats;
19		(F) Thirty sheep, lambs, or goats raised for meat
20		annually: or

1	(G) Sales of five hundred pounds of fish or
2	crustaceans in the applicable fiscal quarter;
3	[and]
4	(5) The grant shall not exceed a total of \$200,000 per
5	qualified feed producer per year; and
6	$\left[\frac{(5)}{(6)}\right]$ The department may request an applicant to
7	provide necessary information for the purposes of
8	verifying flock or herd size or sale weight, as
9	applicable, and feed purchases."
10	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
13	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
14	year 2016-2017 for the livestock revitalization program of the
15	department of agriculture that shall be allocated as follows:
16	(1) \$ to reimburse qualified producers of milk
17	pork, eggs, poultry, beef, sheep, lamb, goats, and
18	seafood, for the cost of feed for beef cattle, dairy
19	cows or milking goats, goats raised for meat, sheep,
20	hogs, fish, crustaceans, and poultry; and

- 1 (2) \$ to reimburse qualified feed developers for
- the costs of development of feed for sale.
- 3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 4 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 6. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 8 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 9 year 2016-2017 for the department of agriculture to identify,
- 10 assess, and validate locally sourced feed ingredients.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 12 of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
