- 3 SECTION 2. Section 15-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 5 "(e) When a registered voter requests an absentee ballot,
- 6 the voter also may include an additional request to receive
- 7 absentee ballots permanently. After receiving a request for
- 8 permanent absentee voter status, the clerk shall mail to the
- 9 voter who requested permanent absentee voter status an absentee
- 10 ballot for all subsequent elections conducted in that precinct.
- 11 The forwarding address for absentee ballots to be permanently
- 12 mailed shall be the mailing address contained in the voter's
