Section 97-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) Any person who: 4 [Wilfully fails] Fails to file any statement or report (1) 5 required by this chapter; (2) [Wilfully files] Files a statement or report 6 containing false information or material omission of 7 8 any fact; Engages in activities prohibited by section 97-5; or 9 (3) Fails to provide information required by section 97-2 10 (4)11 or 97-3; 12 shall be subject to an administrative fine imposed by the commission that shall not exceed \$500 for each violation of this 13 chapter. All fines collected under this section shall be 14 15 deposited into the general fund."
