BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§84-41 Applicability of part. This part [applies to
- 4 legislators, members of the board of education, trustees of the
- 5 office of Hawaiian affairs, the governor, the lieutenant
- 6 governor, and executive department heads and deputies.] shall
- 7 apply to all persons listed in section 84-17(d), except
- 8 delegates to the constitutional convention. This part [does]
- 9 <u>shall</u> not apply to any other officer or employee of the State."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 84-43, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows:
- "(d) The ethics training course shall be held in January
- 13 of each year for those who have not attended the course
- 14 previously. [The course shall last at least two hours in
- 15 length.
