A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFLICTS OF INTEREST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 84-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) No employee shall take any official action directly 3 4 affecting: 5 (1) A business or other undertaking in which the employee has a substantial financial interest; [or] 6 A private undertaking in which the employee is engaged 7 (2) as legal counsel, advisor, consultant, representative, 8 9 or other agency capacity[-]; or A business or other undertaking in which the employee 10 (3) knows or has reason to know that a parent, sibling, or 11 emancipated child of the employee has a substantial 12 13 financial interest. 14 A department head who is unable to disqualify the department head's self on any matter described in paragraphs (1) 15 [and], (2), and (3) will not be in violation of this subsection **16**

- 3 A person whose position on a board, commission, or
- 4 committee is mandated by statute, resolution, or executive order
- 5 to have particular qualifications shall only be prohibited from
