A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN SPENDING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-334, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The candidate and treasurer of the candidate "(a) 4 committee of each candidate whose name will appear on the ballot 5 in the immediately succeeding election shall file preliminary, 6 final, and supplemental reports. 7 The filing dates for preliminary reports are: (1) (A) Thirty calendar days prior to a primary election; 9 (B) Ten calendar days prior to a primary, each 10 special, or each nonpartisan election; and 11 (C) Ten calendar days prior to a general election; 12 provided that this preliminary report does not 13 need to be filed by a candidate who is 14 unsuccessful in a primary, special, or 15 nonpartisan election, or a candidate who is 16 elected to office in the primary, initial **17** special, or initial nonpartisan election.

2		under subparagraph (A) shall be current through
3.		June 30, and all other preliminary reports shall be
4		current through the fifth calendar day before the
5		filing deadline of those other preliminary reports.
6	(2)	The filing date for the final primary report is twenty
7		calendar days after a primary, initial special, or
8		initial nonpartisan election. The report shall be
9		current through the day of the applicable election.
10	(3)	The filing date for the final election period report
11		is thirty calendar days after a general, subsequent,
12		subsequent special, or subsequent nonpartisan
13		election. The report shall be current through the day
14		of the applicable election. The final election period
15		report shall be filed by a candidate who is
16		unsuccessful in a primary, initial special, or initial
17		nonpartisan election or a candidate who is elected to
18		office in the primary, initial special, or initial
19		nonpartisan election.
20	(4)	The filing dates for supplemental reports are:
21		(A) January 31 [after an election year]; and

1	(B) July 31 after an election year.
2	The report shall be current through December 31 for
3	the report filed on January 31 and current through
4	June 30 for the report filed on July 31."

7	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
