A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§444-3 Contractors license board.** (a) There shall be a
4 contractors license board of [~~thirteen~~] fifteen members[~~-~~], each
5 of whom shall have been a resident of and domiciled in the State
6 for not less than five years preceding the member's appointment.

7 (b) Of the board members:

8 (1) [~~Ten~~] Twelve shall be contractors who have been
9 actively engaged in the contracting business for a
10 period of not less than [~~five~~] ten years preceding the
11 date of their appointment[~~-~~] and who hold a valid and
12 unexpired license to operate as a contractor at the
13 time of their appointment. Three of the contractors
14 shall be general engineering contractors, two shall be
15 general building contractors, and seven shall be
16 specialty contractors who do not hold a general



1 engineering or general building contractor license;

2 and

3 ~~[(2) Five shall be general engineering or building~~
4 ~~contractors, five shall be specialty contractors, and~~
5 ~~three shall be noncontractors. No member shall~~
6 ~~receive any compensation for the member's services,~~
7 ~~but each shall be reimbursed for necessary traveling~~
8 ~~expenses incurred in the performance of duties.]~~

9 (2) Three shall be public members who at the time of their
10 appointment do not hold a valid or unexpired license
11 to operate as a contractor, who are not relatives of
12 any board member who holds a contractor's license, and
13 who do not have a financial interest in the business
14 of any board member possessing a contractor's license.
15 For purposes of this section, "relative" means a
16 spouse, fiance, fiancée, parent, sibling, child, or
17 anyone who is related to the person within two degrees
18 of consanguinity; or the spouse, fiance, fiancée,
19 parent, sibling, or child of anyone who is related to
20 the person within two degrees of consanguinity.

21 (c) Each county shall be represented on the board.



1 ~~[(d) No one, except the three noncontractor members, shall~~
2 ~~be eligible for appointment who does not at the time of the~~
3 ~~member's appointment hold a valid and unexpired license to~~
4 ~~operate as a contractor.]~~

5 (d) No member shall receive any compensation for the
6 member's services, but each shall be reimbursed for necessary
7 traveling expenses incurred in the performance of duties.

8 (e) For the purpose of this section, the terms "general
9 engineering contractor", "general building contractor", and
10 "specialty contractor" shall have the same meanings as in
11 section 444-7."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
15 provided that members of the contractors license board on the
16 effective date of this Act shall continue to serve on the board
17 until the expiration of their current term.
