A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
3	to read a	s follows:
4		"PART . PUBLIC RESTROOM MAINTENANCE
5	§171	-A Public restroom maintenance system. (a) The
6	departmen	t shall implement a public restroom maintenance system
7	that incl	udes restrooms located in areas under the jurisdiction
8	of the de	partment, including:
9	(1)	Every park and all park reserves in the state parks
10		system;
11	(2)	Small boat harbors and other areas managed by the
12		division of boating and ocean recreation;
13	(3)	Areas managed by the division of forestry and
14		wildlife, including remote areas with composting
15		toilets within areas managed by the department; and
16	(4)	Any other areas with public restrooms managed by the
17		department.



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1	(b)	The public restroom maintenance system shall ensure	
2	that every public restroom within the system is inspected at		
3	least once every day to ensure that:		
4	(1)	Toilets and showers are clean and operative;	
5	(2)	Sink faucets are operative;	
6	(3)	Soap is available at or near the sinks;	
7	(4)	Floors are clean;	
8	(5)	Trash receptacles are not stuffed or overflowing;	
9		provided that volunteers may empty the trash daily	
10		under the authority of the department;	
11	(6)	Every public restroom has at least one trash	
12		receptacle located near the entrance to the restroom;	
13		and	
14	(7)	An adequate supply of toilet paper is available for	
15		each toilet.	
16	The department may modify the requirements of this subsection		
17	for public restrooms located in remote areas, such as the back		
18	woods, that may have composting toilets or otherwise lack		
19	standard restroom equipment; provided that such facilities are		
20	physically inspected at least one a month.		



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(c) The department shall keep adequate maintenance records
 of each item enumerated under subsection (b).

§171-B Public restrooms asset management system. (a) ТО 3 4 protect the capital improvement investment of the State and in the interests of public health and safety, the department shall 5 establish an asset management system for public restrooms 6 included in the public restroom maintenance system pursuant to 7 8 section 171-A. The asset management system shall document and 9 manage the following information:

10 (1) Daily inspection reports of each restroom; provided
11 that public restrooms located in remote areas that may
12 have composting toilets may have inspection reports
13 less frequently than daily, but not less than monthly;
14 (2) An ongoing assessment of the repair status of each
15 public restroom;

16 (3) An inventory and schedule of needed short-term and 17 long-term restroom repairs, including information on 18 what can be done with existing resources and what 19 additional resources are needed to fully complete 20 repair to every public restroom;



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(4) An estimate of the cost of repairs described under 1 2 paragraph (3) as well as a timetable of completing the 3 repairs; An estimate of the remaining life span of each 4 (5) 5 restroom; and 6 (6) A description and estimated cost of infrastructure 7 improvements, including water and wastewater lines for 8 each restroom. The department shall report to the legislature no 9 (b) 10 later than twenty days prior to the regular session of 2016 and 11 every third regular session thereafter on the status and 12 modifications to the public restrooms asset management system." 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$5,000,000 or so much 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and the 16 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 17 2016-2017 for establishment and maintenance of the public 18 restroom maintenance system pursuant to section 1 of this Act. 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 20 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.



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SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
 the new sections in this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.

Department of Land and Natural Resources; Public Restroom Maintenance System; Public Restroom Asset Management System; Appropriation
