A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOBBYISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 97-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The following persons shall file a statement of
4	expenditures with the state ethics commission on March 31,
5	May 31, [and], January 31 [of each year], the second Friday of
6	August, and the first Monday in November of each general
7	election year and within thirty days after adjournment sine die
8	of any special session of the legislature:
9	(1) Each lobbyist;
10	(2) Each person who spends \$750 or more of the person's or
11	any other person's money in any six-month period for
12	the purpose of attempting to influence legislative or
13	administrative action or a ballot issue by
14	communicating or urging others to communicate with
15	public officials; provided that any amounts expended

for travel costs, including incidental meals and

1		lodging, shall not be included in the tallying of the	
2		\$750; and	
3	(3)	Each person who employs or contracts for the services	
4		of one or more lobbyists, whether independently or	
5		jointly with other persons. If the person is an	
6		industry, trade, or professional association, only the	
7		association is the employer of the lobbyist.	
8	(b)	The March 31 report shall cover the period from	
9	January 1	through the last day of February. The May 31 report	
10	shall cov	er the period from March 1 through April 30. The pre-	
11	primary r	eport, filed on the second Friday of August, shall	
12	cover the	period from May 1 through July 31. The pre-general	
13	election	report, filed on the first Monday in November, shall	
14	cover the	period from August 1 through October 31. The pre-	
15	primary a	nd pre-general election reports shall be filed in	
16	general election years. The January 31 report shall cover the		
17	period from [May 1] November 1 through December 31 of the		
18	previous	year. The report to be filed within thirty days after	
19	adjournme	nt sine die of a special session of the legislature	
20	shall cov	er the period from May 1 through adjournment sine die

- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Lobbyists; Statement of Expenditures; Reporting

Description:

Requires lobbyists and specified individuals to file two additional reports to the Hawaii State Ethics Commission, including one report on the second Friday of August and one report on the first Monday of November in general election years, similarly to the filing frequency that candidate's and the treasurer of candidate committees are required to file pursuant to section 11-334, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
