BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 174C-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b)	Five members shall be appointed by the governor
4	subject t	o confirmation by the senate, in a manner prescribed in
5	subsectio	n (d). Each member shall have substantial experience
6	in the ar	ea of water resource management; provided that [at]:
7	(1)	At least one member shall have substantial experience
8		or expertise in traditional Hawaiian water resource
9		management techniques and in traditional Hawaiian
10		riparian usage such as those preserved by section
11		174C-101[-]; and
12	(2)	Each county shall be represented by a member who is a
13		resident of that county. For purposes of this
14		paragraph, the county of Kalawao shall be considered
15		to be included in the county of Maui.

- shall be the chairperson of the commission. The director of 2
- 3 health shall serve as an ex officio voting member."
- 4 SECTION 2. The nomination and appointment, by and with the
- 5 advice and consent of the senate, of members of the commission
- 6 on water resource management pursuant to section 1 of this Act
- shall take place as expeditiously as possible so that, to the 7
- 8 extent possible, the membership of the commission has at least
- 9 one member representing each county.
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
