# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE COMMISSION ON WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 174C-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:	
3	"(b) Five members shall be appointed by the governor	
4	subject to confirmation by the senate, in a manner prescribed	in
5	subsection (d). Each member shall have substantial experience	
6	in the area of water resource management; provided that $[at]$ :	
7	(1) At least one member shall have substantial experience	е
8	or expertise in traditional Hawaiian water resource	
9	management techniques and in traditional Hawaiian	
10	riparian usage such as those preserved by section	
11	174C-101[-]; and	
12	(2) Each county shall be represented by a member who is	<u>a</u>
13	resident of that county and who also has substantial	
14	experience in the area of water resource management.	
15	For purposes of this paragraph, the county of Kalawao	<u>0</u>
16	shall be considered to be included in the county of	
17	Maui.

- 1 The chairperson of the board of land and natural resources
- 2 shall be the chairperson of the commission. The director of
- 3 health shall serve as an ex officio voting member."
- 4 SECTION 2. The nomination and appointment, by and with the
- 5 advice and consent of the senate, of members of the commission
- 6 on water resource management pursuant to section 1 of this Act
- 7 shall take place as expeditiously as possible so that, to the
- 8 extent possible, the membership of the commission has at least
- 9 one member representing each county. The appointments shall be
- 10 phased in as vacancies occur.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

#### Report Title:

Commission on Water Resource Management; Membership; County Representation

### Description:

Requires the commission on water resource management to consist of at least one member representing each county who is a resident of that county and who also has substantial experience in the area of water resource management. Clarifies that appointments shall be phased in as vacancies occur. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

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
