A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that a reliable
- 2 irrigation system is the lifeline of Hawaii's agricultural
- 3 industry. To ensure that Hawaii's crops receive a steady and
- 4 dependable supply of water, sufficient funding is needed to
- 5 maintain and improve Hawaii's irrigation systems. Increasing
- 6 weather tendencies of extended drought events highlight the need
- 7 for timely repair and maintenance of these systems.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to provide additional funding
- 9 needed for improvements to irrigation systems throughout the
- 10 State.
- 11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$4,150,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
- 15 and the sum of \$3,800,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary
- 16 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is
- 17 appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the purpose of making
- 18 capital improvements to irrigation systems, as follows:

10	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations
11	unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.
12	SECTION 5. The sums appropriated in sections 2 and 3 of
13	this Act shall be expended by the department of agriculture for
14	the purposes of this Act.
15	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
