### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 165, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, as
- 2 amended by section 1 of Act 155, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, is
- 3 amended by amending sections 4 and 5 to read as follows:
- 4 "SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance, from
- 5 time to time, including times subsequent to [June 30, 2015,]
- 6 June 30, 2020, may issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 7 whatever principal amounts the department determines to be
- 8 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized
- 9 in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds
- 10 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the
- 11 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special
- 12 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of
- 13 redemption.
- 14 In making this determination, the department shall comply
- 15 with federal law relating to the exemption from federal income
- 16 taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature authorized by
- 17 this section.
