A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to change the
- 2 structure of the University of Hawaii board of regents to
- 3 include members of key stakeholder groups within the University
- 4 of Hawaii system. These additional members will be from the
- 5 student and faculty populations, with the aim being to increase
- 6 transparency of board of regents activities as well as to have
- 7 more representation in regards to key policy and procedural
- 8 decisions. With additional board representation, students and
- 9 faculty alike will have the opportunity to participate in a
- 10 shared governance structure of our university.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 26-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) The University of Hawaii shall be headed by an
- 14 executive board to be known as the board of regents.
- 15 The board shall consist of [fifteen] eighteen members. At
- 16 least one member shall be [a] an undergraduate student at any
- 17 campus of the University of Hawaii [student] system, including



- 1 any community college, at the time of the initial appointment [-]
- 2 and shall be known as the undergraduate student member. This
- 3 member may be reappointed for one additional term even though
- 4 the member may no longer be [a] an undergraduate student at the
- 5 time of reappointment. At least one member shall be a graduate
- 6 student at any campus of the University of Hawaii system and
- 7 shall be known as the graduate student member. This member may
- 8 be reappointed for one additional term even though the member
- 9 may no longer be a graduate student at the time of
- 10 reappointment. At least one member shall be a faculty member
- 11 for a graduate or research program at any campus of the
- 12 University of Hawaii system and shall be known as the research
- 13 faculty member. At least one member shall be a faculty member
- 14 at any campus of the University of Hawaii system and shall be
- 15 known as the at-large faculty member. The governor shall reduce
- 16 the terms of those initially appointed to each seat on the board
- 17 of regents to provide, as far as practicable, for the expiration
- 18 of three terms each year; provided that the [term] terms of the
- 19 undergraduate student member, the graduate student member, the
- 20 research faculty member, and the at-large faculty member shall
- 21 not be reduced.

1	At least twelve members, except for the undergraduate		
2	student member, the graduate student member, the research		
3	faculty member, and the at-large faculty member, shall represent		
4	and reside in the specified geographic areas as follows:		
5	(1) Two members from the county of Hawaii;		
6	(2) Two members from the county of Maui;		
7	(3) One member from the county of Kauai; and		
8	(4) Seven members from the city and county of Honolulu.		
9	The board shall have the power, in accordance with the		
10	Hawaii constitution and with law, to formulate policy and to		
11	exercise control over the university through its executive		
12	officer, the president of the university. The board shall have		
13	exclusive jurisdiction over the internal organization and		
14	management of the university."		
15	SECTION 3. Section 304A-104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
16	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:		
17	"(a) The affairs of the university shall be under the		
18	general management and control of the board of regents. The		
19	board shall consist of [fifteen] eighteen members who shall be		
20	appointed by the governor from lists of qualified candidates		
21	presented to the governor by the candidate advisory council,		

- 1 pursuant to section 304A-104.6, and shall be confirmed by the
- 2 senate; provided that if the list of qualified candidates
- 3 includes fewer than three candidates at any time during the
- 4 nomination and confirmation process, the governor may request
- 5 that the candidate advisory council reopen recruitment for
- 6 qualified candidates. Members may be removed by the governor.
- 7 Except as otherwise provided by law, state officers shall be
- 8 eligible for appointment and membership.
- 9 The term of each member shall be five years, except as
- 10 provided for the initial appointment in section 26-11; provided
- 11 that the [term] terms of the undergraduate student member, the
- 12 graduate student member, the research faculty member, and the
- 13 at-large faculty member shall each be two years.
- 14 Every member may serve beyond the expiration date of the
- 15 member's term of appointment until the member's successor has
- 16 been appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate in
- 17 accordance with article X, section 6 of the Hawaii State
- 18 Constitution. Members shall serve no more than two consecutive
- 19 [five year] terms; provided that the members who are initially
- 20 appointed to [terms of two years or less] a reduced term,
- 21 pursuant to section 26-11(a), may be reappointed to two ensuing



- 1 [five year] full terms. If a member is to be appointed to a
- 2 second term [of five years], the senate shall consider the
- 3 question of whether to reconfirm the member at least one hundred
- 4 twenty days prior to the conclusion of a member's first [five-
- 5 year term]; provided that if the senate is not in session within
- 6 one hundred twenty days prior to the conclusion of the member's
- 7 first [five-year] term, the member shall continue to serve until
- 8 the senate convenes for the next regular session or the next
- 9 special session for which the senate is authorized to consider
- 10 the question of reconfirmation."
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 304A-104.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- "(b) The candidate advisory council shall:
- 14 (1) Develop and implement a fair and independent procedure
- for evaluating candidates to serve on the board of
- 16 regents;
- 17 (2) Require candidates and members of their immediate
- families to disclose any existing or anticipated
- 19 contracts or financial transactions with the
- University of Hawaii;

1	(3)	Actively solicit and accept applications from
2		potential candidates;
3	(4)	Actively solicit and consider the recommendations and
4		opinions of representative organizations regarding
5		potential candidates for the position of undergraduate
6		student member, graduate student member, research
7		faculty member, and at-large faculty member of the
8		board of regents;
9	[(4)]	(5) Evaluate candidates for the board of regents on
10		their background, experience, and potential for
11		discharging the responsibilities of a member of the
12		board of regents, based upon the qualifications
13		imposed by the Hawaii State Constitution; and
14	[(5)]	(6) Present a list of at least three candidates to
15		the governor for nomination and appointment for each
16		vacant seat on the board of regents of the University
17		of Hawaii."
18	SECT	ION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECT	ION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
21	provided	that any member of the board of regents who was a

- 1 student of the University of Hawaii at the time of initial
- 2 appointment, may continue to serve, and shall be considered the
- 3 graduate student member, until that member's successor has been
- 4 appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate in
- 5 accordance with article X, section 6 of the Hawaii State
- 6 Constitution; provided further that the term of the initial at-
- 7 large faculty member shall be reduced to coincide with the term
- 8 of the current student member of the board of regents; provided
- 9 further that the terms of the undergraduate student member and
- 10 the research faculty member, shall commence on a date that
- 11 prevents the expiration of their terms from occurring during the
- 12 same year as the expiration of the terms of the graduate student
- 13 member and the at-large faculty member.
