RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the fee for a permit 2 authorizing a licensed pyrotechnician to purchase and use aerial 3 fireworks, display fireworks, and articles pyrotechnic, has 4 remained fixed for several years. During this period, the costs 5 to process, review, and approve the permit have increased. 6 The purpose of this Act is to increase the fee charged to 7 keep pace with increased costs for processing, review, and approval of the permit. 8 SECTION 2. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 10 amended to read as follows: "§132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the 11 12 purchase and use of: Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers 13 (1)14 upon payment of a fee of \$25; 15 Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles (2) 16 pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon 17 payment of a fee of [\$110;] \$300; and

1	(3) Any consumer fireworks for the purposes of section
2	132D-5 or for cultural uses that occur at any time
3	other than during the periods prescribed in section
4	132D-3(1) upon a payment of a fee of \$25."
5	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
7	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
