A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE INTEGRATED SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's
- 2 integrated solid waste management goals are to reduce the solid
- 3 waste stream prior to disposal through source reduction,
- 4 recycling, and bioconversion. The state integrated solid waste
- 5 management plan furthers the State's waste management goals and
- 6 ensures progress toward managing the State's waste. Plan
- 7 elements include but are not limited to an assessment of
- 8 existing waste management systems and identification of solid
- 9 waste management issues.
- 10 The legislature further finds that section 342G-29, Hawaii
- 11 Revised Statutes, requires the office of solid waste management
- 12 to prepare revisions to the state integrated solid waste
- 13 management plan following the approval and review of each
- 14 revised county-specific plan. While each county has completed
- 15 its plan revisions, the revision process has been delayed due to
- 16 a lack of funds.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 18 the revision of the state integrated solid waste management



- 1 plan, thus furthering the State's waste management goals and
- 2 ensuring progress toward managing the State's waste.
- 3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2016-2017 to support the revision of the state integrated
- 8 solid waste management plan.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 10 of health for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2053.
