8	bottled water, except as provided in subsection (b).		
9	(b)	The following circumstances shall constitute	
10	exceptions to subsection (a):		
11	(1)	Public health and safety preparedness, emergencies,	
12		investigations, and extended deployments or	
13		activations of the office of hazard evaluation and	
14		emergency response of the department of health or the	
15		department of defense;	
16	(2)	Situations where there is high risk of cross-	
17		contamination with non-potable or contaminated water
