BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 605, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>\$</u> 60	5- Law school faculty members. (a) A faculty	
5	member of	the school of law at the University of Hawaii	
6	established under section 304A-1351 who has graduated from an		
7	accredited law school and been admitted to practice in the		
8	highest court of another state or territory of the United State		
9	or the District of Columbia shall:		
10	(1)	Meet all application requirements, character and	
11		fitness requirements, and application investigation	
12		requirements for admission to practice law in the	
13		State;	
14	(2)	Not be suspended, disbarred, or allowed to practice	
15		only under supervision in any other jurisdiction, nor	
16		have resigned from practice in any other jurisdiction	
17		in lieu of disbarment;	

1	(3)	Have the opportunity to petition the supreme court for	
2		review of any adverse recommendation regarding the	
3		faculty member's character and fitness; and	
4	(4)	Be permitted to apply for pro hac vice status if not	
5		admitted to practice law in this State.	
6	(b)	A faculty member of the school of law at the	
7	University of Hawaii may apply for admission to practice law in		
8	in this State and obtain a license without examination if all		
9	other prerequisites to obtain a license are met by the faculty		
10	member.		
11	<u>(c)</u>	The supreme court may prescribe any additional	
12	qualifications for law school faculty members to apply for and		
13	obtain a license without examination."
