### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§14</u>	1- Affordable farming land trust. (a) The	
5	departmen	t of agriculture shall establish an affordable farming	
6	land trust for the purpose of providing affordable long-term,		
7	renewable leases to farmers.		
8	(b)	The affordable farming land trust may hold title to	
9	land and	lease land to farmers; provided that:	
10	(1)	The lease shall be designed to promote the	
11		establishment of sustainable family farms and to allow	
12		farmers to build equity in their farms;	
13	(2)	The primary use of the land shall be for growing	
14		crops;	
15	(3)	Farm dwellings shall be occupied exclusively by	
16		farmers and their immediate family members;

1	(4)	The terms of the lease shall give the affordable
2		farming land trust the first option to purchase any
3		structural improvement placed on the land; and
4	(5)	The lease may have an initial term of not more than
5		ninety-nine years.
6	(c)	The affordable farming land trust shall be a member-
7	based org	anization and reserve core mission decisions for the
8	members.	
9	(d)_	The affordable farming land trust may:
10	(1)	Adopt, amend, and repeal bylaws governing the conduct
11:		of its business;
12	(2)	Execute, in accordance with its bylaws, all
13		instruments necessary or appropriate in the exercise
14		of its powers;

16	(4)	Buy and sell farm-related structures and facilities;

18	(5)	Receive moneys from donations, membership fees, the
19		State, the counties, or the federal government.

2		primarily for conveyance under long-term ground

4	(2)	Transfers ownership of any structural improvements
5		located on leased parcels to the lessees;
6	(3)	Has its corporate membership open to any adult
7		resident of a particular geographic area specified in
8		the organization's bylaws;
9	(4)	Retains a first option to purchase any structural
10		improvement at a price determined by formula that is
11		designed to ensure that the improvement remains
12		affordable to farmers; and
13	(5)	Is governed by a board of directors that:
14		(A) Includes a majority of members who are elected by
15		the corporate membership; and
16		(B) Is composed of equal numbers of lessees,
17		corporate members who are not lessees, and any
18		other category of persons described in the bylaws
19		of the organization."
