# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DENTISTRY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 448, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§448- Board of dental examiners; summary suspension.
- 5 (a) The board of dental examiners may summarily suspend any
- 6 license issued under this chapter upon a specific determination
- 7 that the failure to take such an action may result in an
- 8 immediate and unreasonable threat to personal safety or of fraud
- 9 that jeopardizes or endangers the health or safety of patients
- 10 as determined by the professional standards of care upon
- 11 consumers, and that, for the protection of the public from the
- 12 possible consequences of such practices, the license should be
- immediately suspended or restricted.
- (b) The order of summary suspension shall include a brief
- 15 statement of findings of fact and conclusions of law and shall
- 16 be served upon the licensee as required by chapter 91. The
- 17 order of summary suspension shall be effective upon service.

1	(c) A licensee served with an order of summary suspension
2	shall have the right to request a hearing to show cause why the
3	order of summary suspension should be terminated. Any request
4	for a hearing shall be made in writing and filed with the board
5	of dental examiners within five business days of service of the
6	order. The board shall hold a hearing within seven business
7	days of receipt of the licensee's request for the hearing to
8	show cause.
9	(d) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, an order
10	summarily suspending a license issued under this chapter shall
11	remain in effect until the effective date of a final decision
12	and order issued by the board of dental examiners in a
13	disciplinary action or the effective date of an order issued by
14	the board of dental examiners terminating the summary suspension
15	following a hearing to show cause, whichever occurs first, but
16	in either case shall not exceed thirty business days.
17	(e) The board of dental examiners shall conduct a hearing
18	for disciplinary action against a licensee whose license has
19	been summarily suspended under this section within twenty
20	business days from the effective date of the order of summary
21	suspension.

- 1 (f) Any attempt by the licensee to continue the practice
- 2 of dentistry or the practice of dentistry by the licensee while
- 3 the license has been summarily suspended shall be grounds for
- 4 revocation of the license and shall be a class C felony."
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 6 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 7 begun, before its effective date.
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
