BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

4	"§201H- Affordable housing; community land trust.		
5	Where a development is required to include a number of		
6	affordable rental housing units pursuant to this chapter, the		
7	required number of affordable rental housing units shall be		
8	reduced by fifty per cent if more than half of the available		
9	units in the development are owned by or subject to a community		
10	land trust.		
11	For purposes of this section, "community land trust" means		
12	a nonprofit organization that:		
13	(1) Acquires parcels of land, held in perpetuity,		
14	primarily for conveyance under long-term ground		
15	<pre>leases;</pre>		
16	(2) Transfers ownership of any structural improvements		
17	located on leased parcels to the lessees; and
