BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 435H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]\$435H-6[+] Eligibility of insurers and plans. The 4 commissioner shall determine eligibility for the inclusion of 5 insurers and plans; provided that all qualified plans and 6 qualified dental plans that apply for inclusion shall be 7 included in the connector [-]; provided further that, as a 8 condition of its license or certificate of authority, any 9 insurer who controls, in any fiscal year and as determined by 10 the commissioner, at least a twenty per cent share of the total 11 market for all policies of accident and health or sickness 12 insurance subject to article 10A of chapter 431 or chapter 432 13 or 432D, shall offer, in the following fiscal year, all of its 14 qualified plans and qualified dental plans for inclusion in the connector and for sale to both qualified individuals and 15 16 qualified employers."
