### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JURORS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that under existing
- 2 statute, self-employed advanced practice registered nurses are
- 3 not able to claim an exemption from jury service. Due to the
- 4 nature of self-employment, these advanced practice registered
- 5 nurses may face loss of income or financial hardship if called
- 6 for jury service.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the State is currently
- 8 facing a severe shortage of healthcare providers. Advanced
- 9 practice registered nurses are recognized in Hawaii as primary
- 10 care providers and provide critical patient care throughout the
- 11 State. To ensure that patient access to care is not
- 12 compromised, it is essential that self-employed advanced
- 13 practice registered nurses be able to serve their patients as
- 14 needed.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to enable self-
- 16 employed advanced practice registered nurses to claim an
- 17 exemption from service as a juror, similar to the exemption
