## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF ELECTRONIC SMOKING DEVICES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the unregulated use
- 2 of electronic smoking devices is potentially hazardous to health
- 3 and is disruptive to an orderly and productive work environment.
- 4 Using a noncombustible electronic smoking device closely
- 5 resembles and purposefully mimics the act of smoking by having a
- 6 user inhale vaporized liquid nicotine created by heat through an
- 7 electronic ignition system.
- 8 The 2014 United States Surgeon General's report on the
- 9 health consequences of smoking states that studies and
- 10 assessments by the Food and Drug Administration and independent
- 11 scientists have demonstrated enormous variability in design,
- 12 operation, and contents, and emissions of carcinogens, other
- 13 toxicants, and nicotine from electronic smoking devices. The
- 14 Food and Drug Administration's testing also suggests that
- 15 "quality control processes used to manufacture these products
- 16 are inconsistent or non-existent".
- 17 The legislature further finds that electronic smoking

- 1 harmful substances, which may appear similar to the smoke
- 2 emitted by traditional tobacco products. The use of electronic
- 3 smoking devices in locations where smoking is prohibited
- 4 threatens to undermine compliance with smoking regulations,
- 5 creates a disturbance that impedes employee performance,
- 6 confuses the public, and reverses the progress that has been
- 7 made in establishing a social norm that smoking is not permitted
- 8 in enclosed or partially enclosed public places and places of
- 9 employment.
- 10 Prohibiting the use of electronic smoking devices in
- 11 enclosed or partially enclosed places where smoking is
- 12 prohibited will reduce the likelihood that employees and the
- 13 public will associate the use of electronic smoking devices in
- 14 enclosed or partially enclosed areas with healthful behavior,
- 15 reduce the likelihood of nonuser exposure to exhaled toxicants
- 16 of potential harm, reduce the likelihood of workplace
- 17 disturbances, enhance employee productivity, and help ensure
- 18 compliance with existing smoking regulations.
- 19 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to prohibit the use
- 20 of electronic smoking devices in places where smoking is

- 1 currently prohibited and to update signage requirements to
- 2 reflect the new prohibition.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 328J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
- 5 inserted and to read as follows:
- 6 ""Electronic smoking device" means any electronic product
- 7 that delivers nicotine or other substances to the person
- 8 inhaling from the device, including but not limited to an
- 9 electronic cigarette, electronic cigar, electronic pipe, vape
- 10 pen, or electronic hookah. "Electronic smoking device" includes
- 11 any component, part, or accessory of such a product, whether or
- 12 not sold separately. "Electronic smoking device" does not
- 13 include drugs, devices, or combination products approved for
- 14 sale by the United States Food and Drug Administration, as those
- 15 terms are defined in the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
- 16 "Tobacco product" means any product that is made from or
- 17 derived from tobacco, which contains nicotine or a similar
- 18 substance, and is intended for human consumption or is likely to
- 19 be consumed, whether smoked, heated, chewed, absorbed,
- 20 dissolved, inhaled, or ingested by any other means, including
- 21 but not limited to a cigarette, cigar, pipe tobacco, chewing

- 1 tobacco, snuff, snus, or an electronic smoking device. "Tobacco
- 2 product does not include drugs, devices, or combination
- 3 products approved for sale by the United States Food and Drug
- 4 Administration, as those terms are defined in the Federal Food,
- 5 Drug, and Cosmetic Act."
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 328J-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 7 amended by amending the definition of "smoke" or "smoking" to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 ""Smoke" or "smoking" means [inhaling or exhaling the fumes
- 10 of tobacco or any other plant material, or burning or carrying
- 11 any lighted smoking equipment for tobacco or any other plant
- 12 material.] inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying any lighted
- 13 or heated tobacco product or plant product intended for
- 14 inhalation in any manner or in any form. "Smoking" includes the
- 15 use of an electronic smoking device."
- 16 SECTION 4. Section 328J-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 "[+]§328J-9[+] Signs. (a) Clearly legible signs that
- 19 include the words "Smoking Prohibited by Law[ " with letters of
- 20 not less than one inch in height] Including E-cigarettes And All
- 21 Other Electronic Smoking Devices" or the international "No

- 1 Smoking" symbol, consisting of a pictorial representation of a
- 2 burning cigarette and a symbol of an electronic smoking device
- 3 enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it, or both,
- 4 shall be clearly and conspicuously posted in and at the entrance
- 5 to every place open to the public and place of employment where
- 6 smoking is prohibited by this chapter by the owner, operator,
- 7 manager, or other person in control of that place.
- 8 (b) In signs required by this section, the words "Smoking
- 9 Prohibited by Law" shall be in letters of not less than
- 10 three-quarters of an inch in height, and the remaining words
- 11 shall be in letters of not less than one-quarter inch in height.
- (c) Any establishment, facility, or outdoor area, or any
- 13 part thereof, where an owner exercises the right to prohibit
- 14 smoking under section 328J-8 prior to September 15, 2015, and
- 15 previously installs signs, in addition to the signs clearly and
- 16 conspicuously posted in and at the entrance to such
- 17 establishment, facility, or outdoor area, or any part thereof,
- 18 that complies with section 328J-9 as enacted prior to
- 19 September 15, 2015, shall be allowed to retain such previously
- 20 installed signs, other than at the entrance to such
- 21 establishment, facility, or outdoor area, or any part thereto,

- 1 and shall not be required to replace such previously installed
- 2 signs with any new signage that includes a symbol of an
- 3 electronic smoking device."
- 4 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on September 1,
- 7 2015.
