BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 347, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§347- Knowing misrepresentation as owner or trainer of
5	service dog; penalty. (a) Any person who knowingly and
6	fraudulently represents the person, through verbal or written
7	notice, as the owner or trainer of a dog that is qualified or
8	identified as a service dog shall be guilty of a misdemeanor
9	punishable by imprisonment for not more than six months or a
10	fine of not more than \$1,000, or both.
11	(b) As used in this section, "owner" means any person who
12	owns an alleged service dog or who is authorized by the dog's
13	owner to use the dog."
14	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun before its effective date.
