A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. (a) The director of transportation shall

 conduct a study examining the feasibility of establishing a

 fifth lane of travel on the ocean side of Farrington highway in
- 4 Nanakuli from Kahe point to Mohihi street, to be used for
- 5 contraflow during rush hour and requiring relocation of the
- 6 existing railroad; and all possible alternatives to establishing
- 7 a fifth lane. The study shall consider:
- 8 (1) A cost-benefit analysis of establishing the fifth
 9 contraflow lane and relocating the existing railroad
 10 and any alternatives to establishing a fifth lane and
 11 relocating the existing railroad;
- 12 (2) Identification and evaluation of desired, intended,
 13 and possibly unintended effects of establishing this
 14 fifth contraflow lane and relocating the existing
 15 railroad versus any alternatives to establishing a
 16 fifth lane and relocating the existing railroad;

- 2 various counties and any other agency or private entity that it
- 3 deems appropriate to conduct the study.
- 4 SECTION 2. The director of transportation shall submit a
- 5 report of findings and recommendations of the feasibility study,
- 6 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later
- 7 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
- 8 of 2016.
- 9 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for the
- 12 feasibility study required by this Act, including the retention
- 13 of necessary and appropriate consultants and professionals.
- 14 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 15 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
