## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 386-80, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$386-80 Examination by impartial physician. The director
- 4 of labor and industrial relations may appoint a duly qualified
- 5 impartial physician, whose specialty is appropriate for the
- 6 injury being examined, to examine the injured employee and to
- 7 report. The fees for such examination shall be paid from the
- 8 funds appropriated by the legislature for the use of the
- 9 department of labor and industrial relations."
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 for
- 13 examinations by appointed duly qualified physicians pursuant to
- 14 section 386-80, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059.



## Report Title:

Workers' Compensation; Impartial Physician; Exam; Appropriation

## Description:

Requires a workers' compensation impartial exam to be conducted by a doctor whose specialty is appropriate for the injury to be examined in cases where the director of labor and industrial relations appoints a doctor to conduct an exam. Appropriates funds for the purpose of this measure. Effective 01/07/2059. (SD1)
