## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established within the department the
4	teacher national board certification incentive program to
5	recognize and support exemplary teaching practice by supporting
6	public school teachers who have achieved national board
7	certification under the certification program of the National
8	Board for Professional Teaching Standards. The teacher national
9	board certification incentive program shall provide:
10	(1) A \$5,000 bonus per year for each public school teacher
11	who maintains current national board certification;
12	(2) \$1,500 upon completing all components of the
13	certification program of the National Board for
14	Professional Teaching Standards;
15	(3) A reimbursement of the remainder of the national board
16	certification application fee upon achievement of
17	national board certification; and

1	The teacher shall receive the additional bonus from
2	the time the school no longer meets any of the
3	criteria of paragraph (4) until the end date of the
4	teacher's ten-year national board certification in
5	effect at the time the school lost its designation, or
6	until the teacher is no longer employed at the school,
7	whichever occurs first."
8	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Report Title:

Teachers; Incentives; Bonus; Title I

## Description:

Authorizes an additional per year bonus for teachers who maintain current national board certification and teach at a school in a focus, priority, or superintendent's zone school under the National Board Certification Incentive Program. Authorizes an additional per year bonus through the end date of a teacher's national board certification, for teachers who received a bonus for teaching at a school in a focus, priority, or superintendent's zone school under the National Board Certification Incentive Program, and continue teaching at that school after the school is no longer so classified.
