A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BROADBAND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that advanced broadband
- 2 services are essential in creating an infrastructure that can
- 3 support an innovative economy and a knowledgeable and
- 4 competitive society in the twenty-first century. Specifically,
- 5 high-speed broadband services at affordable prices are essential
- 6 for the advancement of education, health, public safety,
- 7 research and innovation, civic participation, e-government,
- 8 economic development and diversification, and public safety and
- 9 services.
- 10 The legislature further finds that supporting and
- 11 encouraging public-private partnerships are the most effective
- 12 vehicles for moving forward and completing the Hawai'i broadband
- 13 initiative. The collaborative efforts of the private sector and
- 14 the State, especially efforts focused on research and
- 15 development, are also the most effective way to address the
- 16 infrastructure needs of the State. Under the Hawai'i broadband
- 17 initiative, the State's contribution will provide the



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- 1 development of secure cable landing sites on seven islands,
- 2 while the private sector agencies and academic organizations
- 3 will provide the development of trans-Pacific cable and an off-
- 4 shore high-technology park. Further, the Hawai'i broadband
- 5 initiative will benefit from executive branch support relating
- 6 to regulatory processes and requirements, such as the design and
- 7 preparation of environmental impact statements.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to build
- 9 secure broadband cable landing sites, including necessary
- 10 environmental impact statements, to support economic and social
- 11 development and federal security interests.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 14 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016 and
- 15 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 16 year 2016-2017 to establish seven secure broadband cable landing
- 17 sites two on O'ahu and one each on Kaua'i, Maui, Moloka'i,
- 18 Lana'i, and Hawai'i, and for the performance of island-specific
- 19 environmental impact studies.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 3 of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
