## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BROADBAND.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that advanced broadband
- 2 services are essential in creating an infrastructure that can
- 3 support an innovative economy and a knowledgeable and
- 4 competitive society in the twenty-first century. Specifically,
- 5 high-speed broadband services at affordable prices are essential
- 6 for the advancement of education, health, public safety,
- 7 research and innovation, civic participation, e-government,
- 8 economic development and diversification, and public safety and
- 9 services.
- 10 The legislature further finds that supporting and
- 11 encouraging public-private partnerships are the most effective
- 12 vehicles for moving forward and completing the Hawai'i broadband
- 13 initiative. The collaborative efforts of the private sector and
- 14 the State, especially efforts focused on research and
- 15 development, are also the most effective way to address the
- 16 infrastructure needs of the State. Under the Hawai'i broadband
- 17 initiative, the State's contribution will be to provide the



- 1 secure cable landing sites while the private sector agencies and
- 2 academic organizations will provide the development of a trans-
- 3 Pacific cable. Further, the Hawai'i broadband initiative will
- 4 benefit from executive branch support relating to regulatory
- 5 processes and requirements, such as the design and preparation
- 6 of environmental impact statements.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to build
- 8 secure broadband cable landing sites, including necessary
- 9 environmental impact statements, to support economic and social
- 10 development and federal security interests.
- 11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 14 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
- 15 for the establishment of secure cable landing sites and
- 16 completion of any necessary environmental impact statements.
- 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 18 business, economic development, and tourism and delegated
- 19 through the high technology development corporation for the
- 20 purposes of this section.

- 1 SECTION 3. The appropriation made for the capital
- 2 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
- 3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
- 4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
- 5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
