A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MIXED-USE RESIDENTIAL PROJECTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there are
- 2 underutilized parcels of state land in the urban core of
- 3 Honolulu that could be developed into mixed-use residential
- 4 projects, providing space for government offices, social
- 5 services, and affordable housing. 902 Alder street, Honolulu,
- 6 Oahu, currently set aside by executive order to the juvenile
- 7 court of the first circuit, is one such parcel.
- 8 The legislature further finds that the judiciary and Hawaii
- 9 housing finance and development corporation have entered into a
- 10 memorandum of agreement to develop a mixed-use residential
- 11 project that includes a juvenile services center that would be
- 12 integrated with an affordable rental housing project for working
- 13 families at 902 Alder street. The workforce housing component
- 14 of the mixed-use project will provide approximately one hundred
- 15 eighty units for lower income families.
- 16 The legislature further finds that this mixed-use
- 17 residential project could serve as a model for future
