A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§264- Endangering public transportation. (a) A person
- 5 commits endangering public transportation if such person tampers
- 6 with a public highway, as defined in section 264-1, or a
- 7 facility of public transportation, with intent to cause any
- 8 damage, malfunction, nonfunction, theft, or unauthorized removal
- 9 of material which would result in the creation of a substantial
- 10 risk of death or serious bodily injury to anyone.
- 11 (b) For purposes of this section, "facility of public
- 12 transportation" means any structure, fixture, surface,
- 13 underground object or material, pipes, utility, pole, wire,
- 14 cable, or other equipment, and the appurtenances thereto, that
- 15 is used in connection with facilitating public transportation.
- 16 (c) Endangering public transportation is a class C
- 17 felony."

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
