SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT
COVERING PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT KAIPAPAU,
KOOLAULOA, OAHU, FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE
EXISTING ROCK SEAWALL, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE
OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

1 WHEREAS, portions of the existing rock seawall fronting the
2 property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 5-4-003: seaward of 035,
3 Kaipapau, Koolauloa, Oahu, was placed upon state submerged
4 lands; and
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6 WHEREAS, in late 2014, the Department of Land and Natural
7 Resources' Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands worked with
8 the property owners, August and Veronica Monge, to resolve the
9 encroachment; and
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11 WHEREAS, the Board of Land Natural Resources, at its
12 meeting on February 27, 2015, approved the conservation district
13 use permit request to resolve the encroachment, subject to the
14 owners obtaining appropriate authorization from the State for
15 the occupancy of state lands; and
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17 WHEREAS, on July 10, 2015, under agenda item D-7, the Board
18 of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant of a 55-year non-
19 exclusive easement to resolve the encroachment; and
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21 WHEREAS, the subject area is about 350 square feet, which
22 will be reviewed and approved by the Department of Accounting
23 and General Services' Survey Division; and
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25 WHEREAS, the grantees shall pay the State the fair market
26 value of the easement as consideration of the use of public
27 lands to be determined by an independent appraisal; and
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29 WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires
30 the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of

1 the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state
2 submerged lands; now, therefore,

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4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the
6 House of the Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land
7 and Natural Resources is hereby authorized to issue a term, non-
8 exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged lands
9 fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 5-4-003:
10 seaward of 035, Kaipapau, Koolauloa, Oahu, for the maintenance
11 and repair of the existing rock seawall, and for use, repair,
12 and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon
13 pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
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15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
16 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
17 Board of Land and Natural Resources.

TITLE: CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE
ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT

PURPOSE: To seek the authorization of the Legislature
by concurrent resolution of the issuance of
a term, non-exclusive easement by the Board
of Land and Natural Resources (Board) for
the maintenance and repair of the existing
rock seawall, and for use, repair, and
maintenance of the existing improvements
constructed thereon.

MEANS: Concurrent resolution pursuant to section
171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION: Portions of the existing rock seawall
fronting the property identified as Tax Map
Key: (1) 5-4-003: seaward of 035, Kaipapau,
Koolauloa, Oahu, was discovered to be
encroaching upon state submerged lands. In
late 2014, the Department's Office of
Conservation and Coastal Lands worked with
the property owners, August and Veronica
Monge, to resolve the encroachment.

The Board, at its meeting on February 27,
2015, approved the Conservation District Use
Permit request to resolve the encroachment,
subject to the owners obtaining appropriate
authorization from the State for the
occupancy of state land.

Subsequently, at its meeting of July 10,
2015, under agenda item D-7, the Board
approved a grant of a 55-year non-exclusive
easement to resolve the encroachment.

Section 171-53, HRS, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands. As such, this concurrent resolution has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of section 171-53, HRS.
