
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO COORDINATE WITH VARIOUS STATE
AGENCIES TO CREATE A PLAN TO NAME A SCHOOL, BUILDING, ROAD,
OR AREA UNDER STATE CONTROL AFTER PRESIDENT BARACK H.
OBAMA.

1 WHEREAS, Barack Hussein Obama was born to Barack Obama, Sr.
2 and Ann Dunham on August 4, 1961, in Honolulu, Hawaii; and
3

4 WHEREAS, Barack Obama spent his formative years attending
5 high school at Punahou School on the island of Oahu; and
6

7 WHEREAS, in 1985, Barack Obama began working on the south
8 side of Chicago as a community organizer for low-income
9 residents in the Roseland and the Altgeld Gardens communities;
10 and

12 WHEREAS, in 1991, Barack Obama graduated magna cum laude
13 from Harvard Law School; and
14

15 WHEREAS, after being elected to the Illinois Senate in
16 1996, Barack Obama drafted legislation on ethics and worked to
17 expand health care services and early childhood education
18 programs for low-income families; and
19

20 WHEREAS, in 2005, Barack Obama was sworn in as a United
21 States senator representing Illinois, and was only the third
22 African American to hold a United States Senate seat since
23 Reconstruction; and

25 WHEREAS, on January 20, 2009, Barack Obama was sworn in as
26 the forty-fourth president of the United States of America; and

28 WHEREAS, under President Obama's leadership, the United
29 States economy has thrived, the national deficit has shrunk by



1 two-thirds, and the national unemployment rate has dropped below
2 5.3 percent; and

4 WHEREAS, under the leadership of President Obama, the
5 landmark Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act was passed,
6 allowing more than sixteen million Americans to have affordable
7 and quality health care; and
8

9 WHEREAS, additional accomplishments of President Obama
10 include ending United States combat operations in Iraq, winning
11 the Nobel Peace Prize, signing into law the Dodd-Frank Wall
12 Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and beginning the
13 process of normalizing relations with Cuba; and

15 WHEREAS, President Obama is one of numerous individuals of
16 African American heritage who have played integral roles in the
17 history of Hawaii, including Anthony D. Allen, Betsey Stockton,
18 Thomas McCants Stewart, Alice Ball, Helene Hale, and William F.
19 Crockett; and

21 WHEREAS, President Obama's legacy includes not just his
22 historic role as the first African American United States
23 president, but also his tireless dedication as a progressive and
24 forward thinking leader; now, therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the
28 House of Representatives concurring, that the Governor is
29 requested to coordinate with various state agencies including
30 but not limited to the Department of Transportation, University
31 of Hawaii System, Department of Education, and Department of
32 Accounting and General Services to create a plan to name a
33 school, building, road, park, or other property under the
34 control of the State in honor of President Barack Obama; and

36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to
37 submit a joint report of the status of the plan to the
38 Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of
39 the Regular Session of 2017; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Foundation on Culture
2 and the Arts is requested to commission a statue of President
3 Barack Obama to be located on state or federal property; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
6 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Director
7 of Transportation, Comptroller, President of the University of
8 Hawaii System, Chairperson of the Board of Education,
9 Superintendent of Education, Executive Director of the State
10 Foundation on Culture and the Arts, and President Barack Obama.
