SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE BOARD OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES AND COUNTIES
TO COORDINATE A COMPREHENSIVE, STATEWIDE VOLUNTEER EFFORT
TO CLEAN AND BEAUTIFY ALL STATE AND COUNTY BEACHES AND
STATE PARKS WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE JURISDICTIONS.

1 WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources has
2 jurisdiction over all public lands, including state parks,
3 pursuant to section 26-15(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes, as well
4 as beaches of the State; and

6 WHEREAS, the various counties each have statutory
7 responsibility for maintenance over their respective shores and
8 beaches pursuant to sections 46-11.5, 46-12, and 46-65, Hawaii
9 Revised Statutes; and
10

11 WHEREAS, ensuring clean and beautiful parks and beaches is
12 an important function of government; and
13

14 WHEREAS, clean and scenic parks and beaches benefit the
15 general public as well as visitors and the tourism industry; and

17 WHEREAS, state and county governments cannot generally
18 provide sufficient services for clean and beautiful parks and
19 beaches; and

21 WHEREAS, volunteers could help state and county governments
22 immensely in the effort to clean and beautiful state and county
23 parks; and

25 WHEREAS, businesses, non-profit organizations, government,
26 unions, community organizations, and faith-based organizations
27 may wish to volunteer their time to assist the Department of
28 Land and Natural Resources and counties keeping parks and
29 beaches clean; now, therefore,

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
 2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, the
 3 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of Land
 4 and Natural Resources and counties are encouraged to coordinate
 5 a comprehensive, statewide volunteer effort to clean and
 6 beautify all state and county beaches and state parks within
 7 their respective jurisdictions; and

 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that volunteers for the statewide
 10 effort may come from businesses, non-profit organizations,
 11 government, unions, community organizations, and faith-based
 12 organizations; and

 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and
 15 Natural Resources establish a website to assist persons who
 16 volunteer to clean and beautify state and county beaches and
 17 parks so that the volunteers can be easily unified in their
 18 efforts and also record the places and hours where they have
 19 volunteered; and

 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 22 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor,
 23 Chairperson of the Board of Land and Natural Resources, Mayor of
 24 the City and County of Honolulu, Mayor of the County of Kauai,
 25 Mayor of the County of Maui, and Mayor of the County of Hawaii.
